MODEL OF THE MONTH:

Sidney Hipp showed his "Tough Wing", a Brian Crystal design. The 50 inch wing is hot wire cut from EP foam. It is powered with a 35-40 size electric motor managed by a 60 Amp ESC using a 3S-5000 mAh LiPo. He is using Corona metal gear servos on the elevons. He used Testors Red spray for visibility, and added carbon fiber rods for reinforcement. The wing is available from our local Hobby Town USA store.


