\$85 - Phoenix Model Extra 330S ARF

Thank you for checking out my ad for this Phoenix Model Extra 330S RC model. It is designed for a .61 to .91 engine and was actually flown using a 4 stroke engine. The cowls are still available, so you can buy a new one and cut it out to your engine. The plane flew with 6 standard sized servos and used two for ailerons and two for elevators. It also used a pull pull system on the rudder, which is included. As this did fly on a 4 stroke, it also includes a remote glow starter to make it easier to start the engine. The plane has a 62.3 inch wingspan and is 58.7 inches long. The booklet is included in the sale so you can see all the other technical information. I have other pictures I can send you, or we can arrange a
