#### Model of the Month:



Kevin Pellone – Flite Test Mini Trainer

Kevin Pellone showed his Flite Test "Mini Trainer" that he built for his 13-year-old nephew. He reported that it was easy to fly and after some simulator time his nephew successfully flew it and was able to land it solo. His wife Dawn also flew it successfully. The trainer was easy to build and was relatively inexpensive; plane \$25, power system \$55, battery \$10.



Dean Lukover – Sig Hog Bipe

Dean Lukover showed his Sig Hog Bipe that he built. He enlarged the rudder a little and added a battery hatch to the under belly for easy access. He also had custom Union Jack flag decals made for the plane. The all up weight was 7 lbs. and is powered with a Super Tiger 61 ABC. The maiden flight took about three weeks. The first attempt resulted

in getting sunscreen in his eyes, and an engine that he wouldn't start because he couldn't get the radio and model to communicate using the wrong transmitter. The second attempt had the right radio and the engine started, but it needed a slight fuel needle tweak. That didn't happen because his hand got in the way of the prop, **OUCH!** The third time was the charm. He was able to fly the plane well and landed it in one piece!



Burf Tunnell showed his J3 Cub that he bought from Hobby King for \$150. The ARF has a 56-inch wing span. The plane had excellent detailed finished foam and decals. He wasn't too thrilled with the poor assembly instructions, but as an experienced builder he figured it out.
