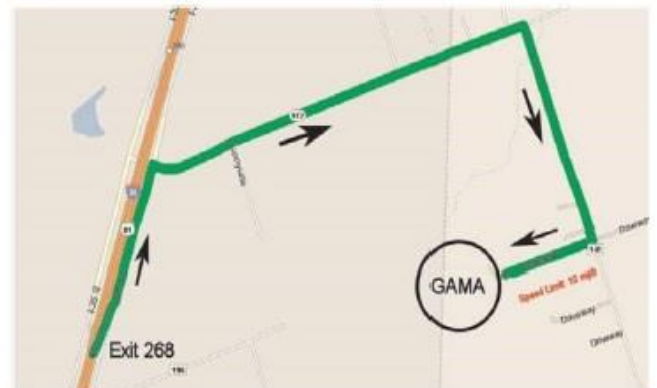

Directions to the G.A.M.A. Field:

- ⑩ Go north of Georgetown on I35 and take exit 268.
- ⑩ Go 1 mile north on the I35 frontage road to FM 972.
- ⑩ Turn right on FM 972 and go 1.33 miles to CR 141.
- ⑩ Turn right on CR 141 and go 0.7 miles to the Charolias Guice Farms (Sign is missing, only the frame is left) at 655 CR 141 (Black Mailbox on left).
- ⑩ Turn right onto the dirt road and go 0.37 miles down the dirt road, going past the house on the right.
- ⑩ The field will be straight in front of you on the other side of the tree line.
